With step-by-step guidance, you'll begin by exploring essential brush marks in black ink, developing the control, movement and confidence needed for this traditional technique. You'll then paint graceful bamboo before progressing to the flowing beauty of wisteria, learning how a few carefully placed brushstrokes can capture both strength and delicacy.

You will gain an understanding of the philosophy and techniques behind this fascinating art form, and you'll leave with an example of your work, new skills and plenty of inspiration to continue your Chinese brush painting journey at home.
