

Description: Watercolour Seascapes (2.5 Hours)

Capture the beauty and atmosphere of the sea in this relaxing watercolour workshop, suitable for both beginners and those with previous painting experience. Using the wonderfully fluid wet-on-wet technique, you will discover how water and colour work together to create soft skies, rolling waves and coastal moods that are unique every time. With gentle guidance, you will explore how to build layers, blend colour and embrace the unexpected effects that make watercolour such an expressive medium. Throughout the session you will create a series of small A6 seascapes, perfect for mounting, turning into greetings cards or giving as thoughtful handmade gifts.

Working on a smaller scale allows you to experiment freely and build confidence without feeling overwhelmed. It's a chance to slow down, enjoy the process of painting and leave with a collection of beautiful miniature artworks inspired by the coast. All materials and equipment are provided.
